



Spartan Spirit Day Dress Code

Spirit Days are opportunities for students to dress in school-sanctioned spirit wear merchandise and show their Spartan pride! Spirit Days will be scheduled and announced throughout the year most often in connection with athletic or other special events. Please contact Dean of Students Mr. Breithaupt (cbreithaupt@nwclassical.org) with questions regarding Spirit Days. The Spirit Day dress code outlined below will be enforced as an alternate dress code.

The Spirit Day dress code is as follows:

- Tops and outerwear: Only official NCA spirit wear (clothing issued by the school with an NCA/Spartan logo) is permitted. NCA student athletes may wear their warm up shirts but not athletic singlets/jerseys that are worn during games/meets.
- Pants, jeans, skirts, skorts, and khaki-style shorts are permitted. Shorts must be no shorter than fingertip length when arms hang straight. Skirts must be no shorter than two inches above the knee.
- **Not permitted:** open-toe or open-back shoes, athletic shorts, cut-offs, leggings / yoga pants, sweatpants, warmup / wind pants, transparent clothing, or clothing with holes or rips. Face paint and tattoos are not permitted.
- Students should still bring and wear their regular PE uniforms and athletic shoes if they have PE class.
- If a student chooses not to participate in Spirit Day, they must wear their regular uniform in accordance with the uniform policy.
- On regular uniform days: Students may not wear spirit wear; the official fleece jacket is the only outer garment that may be worn inside the building.
